Summary

This project is a collaboration between researchers with lived experience of trauma based at King's College London and Traumascapes. The purpose is to explore the terms that people use to describe having lived experience of violence, abuse and trauma. We are also interested in the relationships between these terms and our identities, relationships and healing journeys.

Who

We would like to speak with adults aged 18+ who self-identify as having experienced violence, abuse, and/or trauma, and who use this lived experience in art, research or activist practice.

What

If you choose to participate, you will take part in one interview (approximately 1h) where we will talk about the terms and why. You will also be invited to an optional focus group (2h plus break) where we will review the findings.
