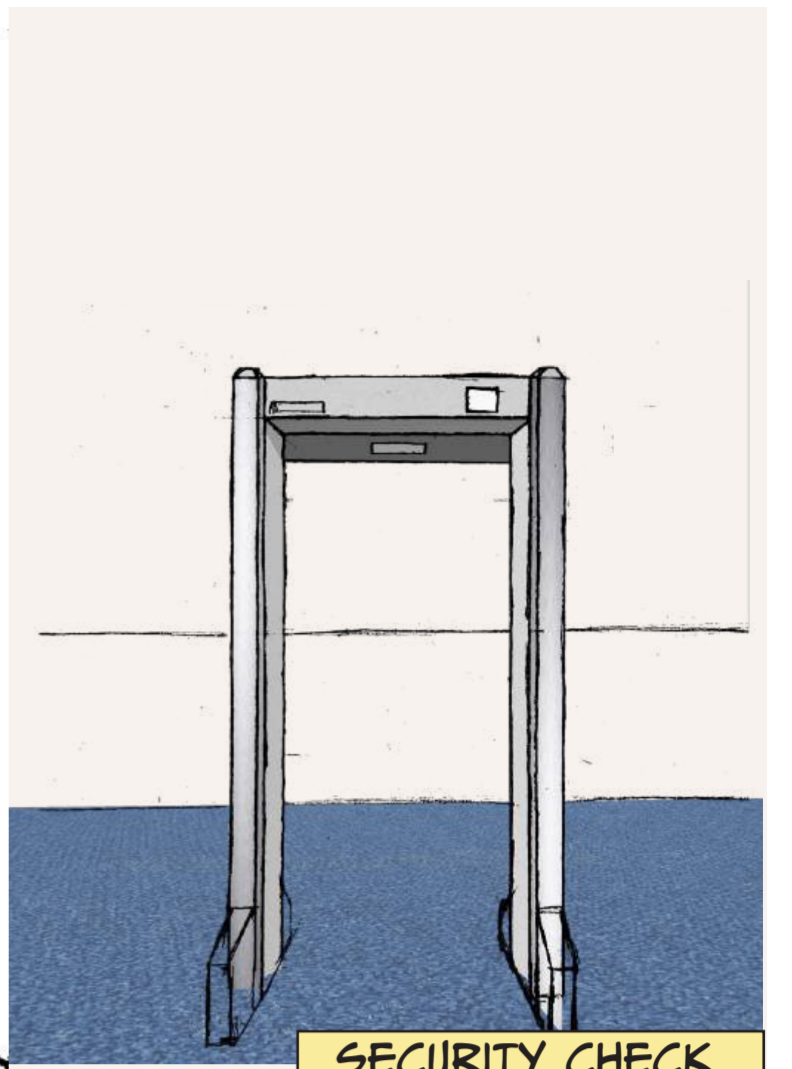


A DAY IN FAMILY COURT

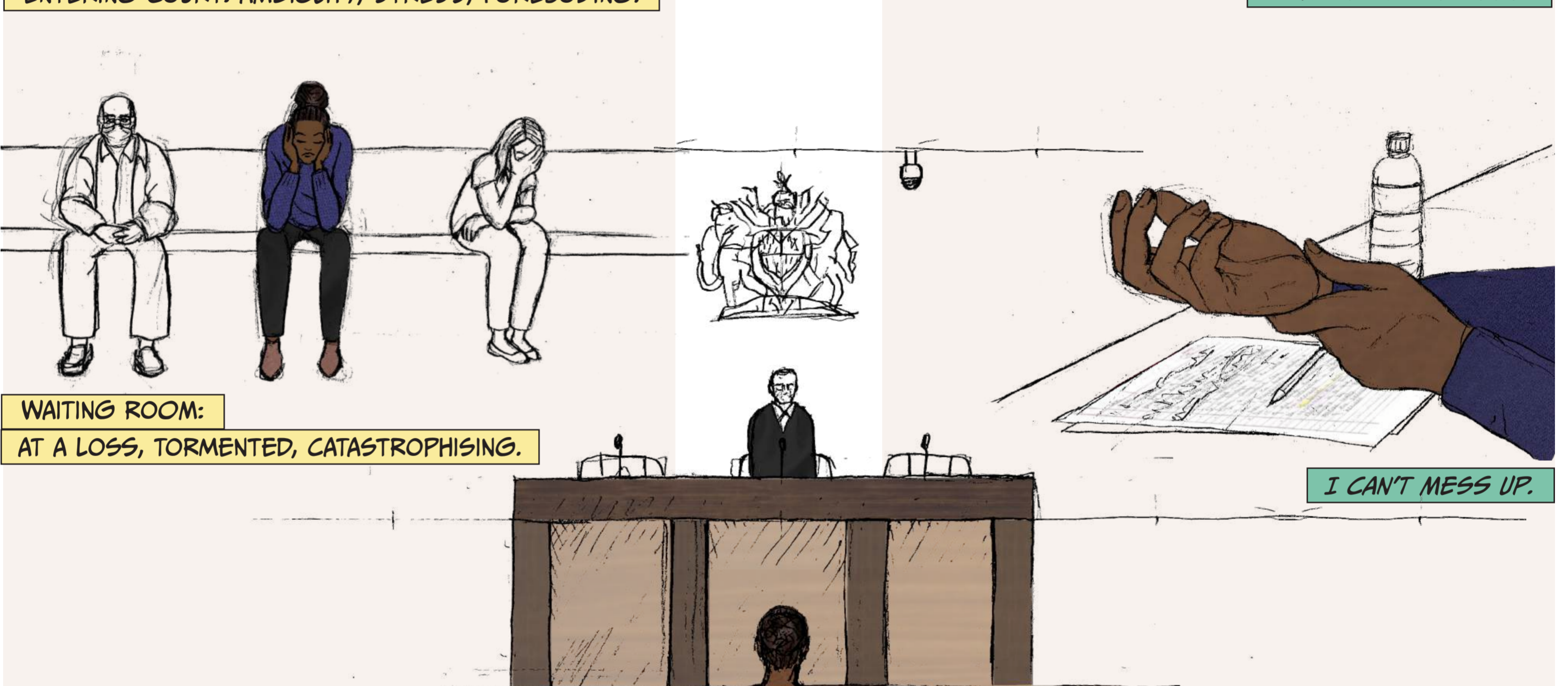


ENTERING COURT: AMBIGUITY, STRESS, FOREBODING.
